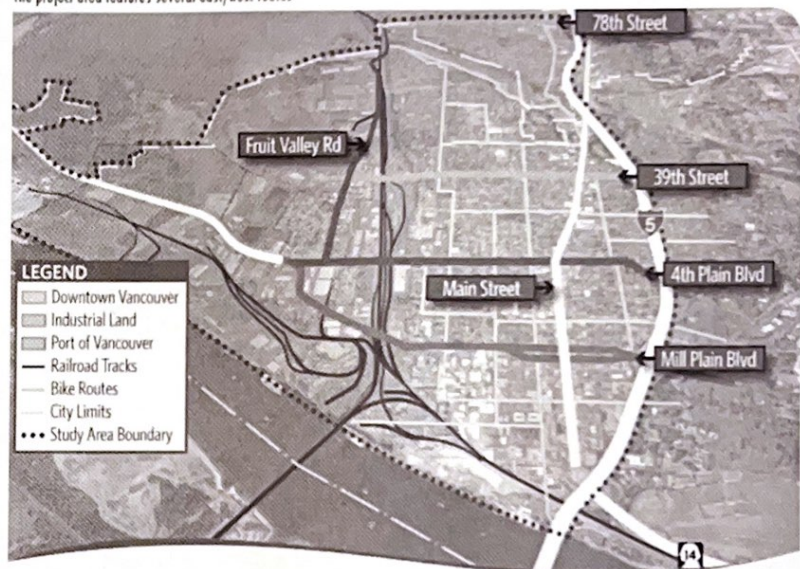

Many residents are concerned about cars going too fast on Lincoln Ave and no safe paths for bikes or pedestrians. This year we have done a couple things to help address those concerns and move us closer to improving the situation.

STREET CALMING ON LINCOLN AVE. We have attended Neighborhood Traffic Safety Alliance (NTSA) meetings regularly where we applied for a permanent radar speed sign to be placed on Lincoln Ave similar to what is seen on 39th Street. Our pre-application has been approved and now we move on to the final application due by July 31,
